5. Given the “widespread suffering” of the Great Depression, list all those whom Roosevelt believes have a responsibility to care for “the victims.”
6. What did both Protestant and Catholic churches view as a central problem in society?
7. Did Rabbi Israel view the economic order as an invention of God or of man?
8. Does Roosevelt believe the rich should be involved in social action? Explain.
