Questions related to The Grimké Sisters on Slavery

- 1. Did the laws of Moses and the slave codes both deprive slaves of all their rights?
- 2. Identify the two biblical precepts that were at odds with American slavery.
- 3. Were female slaves ever purchased for any other reason than to work? Explain.
- 4. Why do you think a beautiful female *mulatto* would fetch such a high price?
- 5. Did slaveholding fathers ever sell their own daughters, and did slaveholding brothers ever sell their own half-sisters?
- 6. How did the sleazy behavior of some slaveholding men affect white Southern women?
- 7. Discuss how the North's fear of racial amalgamation helped perpetuate slavery.

8. The North purchased the South's cotton, sugar, and rice. As a region, the South was agricultural and possessed very little manufacturing. The North had a growing manufacturing sector and even produced the whip used by overseers on southern plantations. Describe how attuned the northern manufacturer of the whip was to the needs of the overseers.
